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EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION PROGRAMMING

The Hampton School Board recognizes the usefulness and potential that district cable television and the designated educational channel makes possible. The goal of the district’s educational access channel is to improve communication with students, parents and the community regarding school district related matters. The district recognizes the necessity and responsibility for regulating access to and use of the educational channel.

Programs and announcements that are consistent with and supportive of the policies, goals and objectives of the School Board and consistent with applicable laws and regulations, may be permitted for airing on the district’s educational access channel.

- Channel 13 will broadcast programs events and activities that feature students and staff.
- Broadcasts will include but not limited to, sporting events, student assembly presentations, exhibitions and demonstrations.

The educational access channel shall not cablecast programs which are sponsored by individuals, private organizations or non- educational entities; or programs which provide political commentary or opinions.

In all cases, access to school district cable facilities and programming capabilities will be limited to individuals, groups, and or organization whose stated purposes are consistent with Board policy and guidelines.

Should a disagreement arise respecting use of the school district cable facilities the Board will make the final determination, but only after all administrative remedies have concluded.
