

BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS

To become a candidate for the School Board, a person must be a registered voter in the District.

No person holding the office School Board member shall at the time hold the office of School District moderator, Treasurer or Auditor. No person employed on a salaried basis by a School Administrative Unit or by a School District within a School Administrative Unit shall be a School Board member in any district of the School Administrative Unit. Salaried positions shall include, but are not limited to, the following: teacher, custodian, administrator, secretary, school bus driver (if paid by the district), school lunch worker and teacher's aide.

Candidates for the School Board should be mindful that the position requires significant time, effort and commitment to the school and community. Individuals who do not feel they will be able to provide significant time, effort and commitment are discouraged from seeking candidacy.

The same qualifications shall exist when the School Board seeks to fill vacancies.
