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BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE

The Hampton School District has decided to implement a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) policy. The BYOD policy will allow students to bring their own personal computing devices to school to enhance the instructional learning process.

However, with greater access to the internet, comes greater responsibility for students, parents, and teachers to work together to make certain this privilege is used properly.

Devices Permitted at School

- *Laptops
- *Netbooks
- *eReaders
- *Cell Phones/SmartPhones
- *Tablets (iPad, Android, Windows)
- **The above listed devices must be capable to connect to WiFi.

Expectations of the Students

- *Devices are to be used for academic purposes; if a student is not using their device appropriately it will be confiscated by teachers. The device will later be returned to parents. Additional violations could result in discipline consequences and loss of BYOD privileges.
- *Devices are to be 'OFF' when they are not being used for academic purposes.
- *STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO SHARE PERSONAL DEVICES AT ANYTIME!

Connecting to the Internet

Hampton School District provides a 'Guest Wireless Network' to which students will have access.

Software

Students/families are responsible for technical support and updates to their own devices. Free downloads or applications may be necessary to participate in some activities.

Damage/Loss/Theft of Device

Any student owned device brought to school is the responsibility of the student. Hampton School District takes no responsibility to search for lost or stolen devices nor is there any financial responsibility by Hampton School District for damaged, lost or stolen personal computing devices.

Teacher Absence

A substitute teacher will not have the experience, knowledge or professional development in the use of BYOD in the District, so personal devices for that day will not be used in that particular class.

Printing Documents

Students will not be able to access printers from their personal computing devices.
