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STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

Students using District transportation must understand that they are under the jurisdiction of the School from the time they board the bus until they exit from the bus.

Students are expected to act in an orderly manner while riding school buses. The driver of the bus will be in charge at all times and will be directly responsible to the Principal, and/or designee, whenever a problem develops. Students not complying with rules established in the Student Use of Transportation Contract while on a school bus will have their names submitted by the driver of the bus to the Principal, and/or designee, immediately. He/she, in turn, will complete a Bus Discipline Warning Notice and give the notice to the student to take home for a parent's signature. The student must then give the signed notice to the Principal, and/or designee, the next time they ride the bus. This does not preclude immediate suspension by the Principal and/or designee on the first offense if, in his/her opinion, the offense warrants such action. The second time a student's name is turned in to the Principal, and/or designee, the parents will be notified that their child may be suspended from riding the bus for a specific period of time, which could be for the remainder of the year.
